The name of the Society is 'The Kalgidhar Society' herein-after called the Society.

2. Office:

The registered office of the Society shall be situated at such a place as the Governing Body of the Society may decide from time to time. At present, the office of the Society shall be located at Village Baru, Post Office Machher, Tehsil Pachhad, District Sirmur, Himachal Pradesh.

3. Objects:

The objects for which the Society is formed are as unders-

- 1) to promote peace through spiritual resurrection, which is according to the wishes, blessings and guidelines of His Holiness Saint Attar Singh Ji Maharaj and Saint Teja Singh Ji, who left this world in 1927 and 1965 respectively and merged with 'God';
- ii) to establish the main advance centre of philosphical and spiritual studies at Saint Attar Singh Harl Ashram, Haru (Himachal Pradesh) with coordinating similar types of centres in other parts of the country;

Rules and Regulations of The Kalgidhar Soffety

Rule-1.

Definitions

In these rules unless the content otherwise requires:

- (a) The Society means *The Kalgidhar Society*
- (b) "The General Body" means the general body of the Society."
- (a) "The Governing Body" means the Governing Body of the Society."

- (d) "The President" means the President of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (6) "The Associate President" means the Associate President of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (f) "The Vice President" means the Vice President of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (g) "General Secretary" means the Principal Secretary of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (h) Governing Body of the Society.
- (1) "Adviser" means the Adviser of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (1) "Treasurer" means the treasurer of the Governing Body of the Society.
- (k) Year means the period commencing from lat April to March.

Rule-2.

Memberships:

- (a) Every member of the Society shall pay a subscription of Rs.1000 per year. He shall cease to be a member of the Society if he fails to pay his subscription for three months without any reasonable cause. He may be re-admitted on payment by him of all arrears.
- (b) All members shall have the right to vote at the meeting of the General Body.
- (c) The Governing Body shall have the discretion to admit any person as member to the society with a majority vote to whom it considers fit by virtue of his having rendered outstanding services to the Society in furtherence of the objects of the Society.

Rule-3.

Authorities of *The Kaldighar Society* The authorities of the Society shall be:

- (a) General Body.
- (b) The President.
- (c) The Governing Booking

Rule-8.

Procedure for Election of the Governing Body.

- The total number of the members shall be eleven. (a)
- The election of the members of the Governing Body will (309 be held in the General Body meetings of the Society by a majority of vote of the members present.

Rule-9:

Meetings

- (a) The annual General meeting of the General Body shall be held at such time, date and place as may be determined by the President or General Secretary or Secretary authorised by him. In general, the meeting will be convened in the month of April.
- (b) The President may also convene a General Body meeting of the society, when he thinks necessary.
- (c) Six members of the General Body including at least three members of the Governing Body may by a letter addressed to the President at least 21 days in advance requisition a special meeting of the General Body. On receipt of such requisition, the President shall convene a meeting.
- (d) At all the meetings of the General Body, 1/3rd of the total numbers shall constitute the quorum.
- (e) The meetings of the General Body shall be convened by the President by giving a three weeks clear notice to all the members of the Society specifying therein the place, date and time of the meeting.
- (f) The meeting of the Governing Body shall be convened by the President once in 6 months or at shorter intervals, if necessary.
- (g) The meeting of the Governing Body shall be convened by the President by circulating a notice to all the members of the Governing Body at least 21 days in advance.
- (h) At all the meetings of the Governing Body 1/3rd members shall constitute the quorum provided that, if a meeting is adjourned for lack of quorum and then meets again to transact the same business, no quorum shall be necessary.
- (1) At the meetings of the General Body as also of the Governing Body, the President shall preside over and in his absence, the Associate President, will preside over, Vice President will preside over when both President and Associate Presidents are absent. In the absence of all three, any member of the Governing Body may be voted to the Chair.

Business by circulation of Papers

Rule-11:

Powers of the Governing Body:

- (a) The Governing Body of the Society shall have the powers to frame regulation and to alter, smend and repeal them from time to time for the administration and management of the affairs of the Kalgidhar Society' end for carrying out its objectives in accordance with the provisions of Societies Registration Act.
- (b) To prepare and sanction indget estimates, the sanctioning of expenditure, making and execution of contracts, the investment of funds of Society and accounts and audit.

Rule-12#

Bye Laws:

"The Kalgidhar Society' may frame bye-laws which are not inconsistant with the Memorandum of Association Rules and Regulations and Societies Registration act. 1860 for carrying out the 'purpose of the Society for its' day to-day administration.

Rule-13:

Subject to the Memorandum of Association, Rules and Regulations, the Governing Body shall have the powers:

- (a) To enter into arrangement with the Govt. ofIndia, State Governments and other Public or Private Organisations for implementation of its programme and for securing and accepting endowments, grant-in-aid, donations or gift on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
- (b) To acquire by gift, purchase, lease or otherwise any property, movable or immovable, which may be necessary or convenient for the purpose of the Society and to construct, alter and maintain building or buildings for the purpose of the Society.
- (c) To draw, accept, endorse, discount and negotiate promisery notes, bills of exchange, cheques or other negotiable instruments with the Central or State Governments.

To invest the funds of the vocatty in such securities or in such manners as may, from time to time, be decembed by the Governing Body and from time to time, to sell or transfer such investment. (a)

- To take over and acquire by purchase, gift, donations (a) or otherwise from Governments and other institutions/ organisations, public or private bodies as well as from individuals movable or immovable properties or other funds, together with any attendant obligations and engagements not inconsistent with the objectives of the Society.

- The funds of the Society shall be deposited in Nationalised Banks and shall not be withdrawn except by a cheque signed by the President and one of the members of the Governing Body or by such other two members of the Governing Body as may be duly empowered in this behalf by the Governing Body. Rule-16:

Dissolution:

If upon the dissolution of the Society, there shall remain after the satisfaction of its liabilities any property, the same shall not be paid or distributed amongst the members of the Society or any of them, but shall be given over to some other similar type of society with comparable purposes according to the procedure laid down under the applicable law in the Societies Registration Act XXI, 1960.

Accounts and Audit:

The Society shall maintain such books of accounts in relation to its receipts and expenditure in such manner as the Governing Body may determine in consultation with the Auditors of the Society. The annual account of the Society together with the audit report thereon shall be laid before the General Body at its annual meeting as far as practicable. If the statement of audited accounts be not ready by the date of the annual meeting, it shall be placed before the General Body at the subsequent meeting.

Amendments to the Rules and Regulations of the Society shall be made by the General Body only by the majority vote at a meeting convened specifically for the purpose in accordance with the provisions laid in the Societies Registration Act, 1860.

Rule-20:

Act XXI 1860:

All the provisions of the Societies Registration Act as applicable in the State of Himachal Pradesh (India) shall apply to the Society except for the Items expressly covered here-to-fore.
